Some facts about Eritrea



Nestling in the Horn of Africa, with a population of around 5 million, Eritrea's capital is Asmara. This small country is

bordered by Sudan in the west, Ethiopia in the south, and Djibouti in the southeast. The northeast and east of the country have an extensive coastline on the Red Sea, directly across from Saudi Arabia and Yemen. The Dahlak Archipelago and several of the Hanish Islands are part of Eritrea.

Eritrea is divided into six regions (zobas), based on their respective hydrological properties. This provides each administration with sufficient control over its agricultural capacity,



and to eliminate historical intraregional conflicts.



The country is virtually bisected by one of the world's longest mountain ranges,

formed by the processes that formed the Great Rift Valley, with fertile lands to the west, descending to desert in the east. Eritrea, at the southern end of the Red Sea, is the home of the fork in the rift. The Dahlak Archipelago and its fishing grounds are situated off the sandy and arid coastline.
